⇒ Preparing for a Camping Trip

Antony has just bought some camping gear, but he wants some advice from Pamela, a camping enthusiast, about other gear he should bring.

5 Antony: Hey Pamela, I decided to follow your lead.^{*} I just bought a tent and sleeping bags, and I'll head out on my first family camping trip next weekend!

10 Pamela: That's great! I think you'll enjoy camping. By the way, did you make a camping reservation?¹ Where are you planning to go camping?

15 Antony: I reserved a campsite at Longman Camping Site. But besides a tent and sleeping bags, what else should I bring?

20 Pamela: If you're committed to^{*} this activity, I think it's worth investing in a canopy. It's **fundamental**² for providing **shade**³ or protection in case it rains. Additionally, some cooking gear is necessary for a comfortable camping experience.

25 Antony: Great idea! Say,^{*} would you mind going shopping with me for some more gear tomorrow? Your **expertise**⁴ would be invaluable.

30 Pamela: Sure, I'd be happy to come with you. I wouldn't say I'm an expert, but I don't think I'd steer you wrong^{*} on some basic **purchases**⁵.

⇒ Purchasing Some Camping Gear

35 At the camping gear store, Pamela advises Antony on some cooking gear.

Antony: Now that I've picked out the sleeping pads and canopy, I also want to get some cooking gear.

40 Pamela: OK. For starters,^{*} I'd recommend getting a folding table and a couple of camping chairs. It'll make cooking and eating much more comfortable.

45 Antony: Good call.^{*} And since we'll probably have a hot pot or a camp barbecue for food, maybe something to keep the food fresh?

50 Pamela: Yeah, a cooler is pretty much a necessity, and for the cooking itself, a **portable**⁶ gas burner is hard to beat.^{*}

Antony: Got it. How about cookware?^{*} They've got entire sets here for sale.

55 Pamela: Well, since you're just getting your feet wet,^{*} I'd suggest bringing your own cookware and utensils^{*} from home. That way, you won't have to shell out^{*} for a complete set right now.

60 Antony: That makes sense. And if it turns out that camping isn't my cup of tea^{*} after all, I'll be glad I didn't buy a bunch of stuff I won't want to use again.

65 Pamela: Exactly. But I think you're going to love it, and with any luck,^{*} we can make a trip together sometime.

* **1. reservation** [ˌrezəˈveɪʃən] *n.* 預約、預訂；保留
I made a **reservation** at a restaurant to celebrate my sister's birthday.

* **2. fundamental** [ˌfʌndəˈmentl] *adj.* 最重要的、不可或缺的；基本的、基礎的
Respect for others' opinions is **fundamental** for effective communication.

* **3. shade** [ʃeɪd] *n.* 陰涼處、樹蔭；陰影部分；(色彩) 濃淡、深淺
The trees provided the farm workers some welcome shade from the hot sun.

* **4. expertise** [ˌekspəˈtiːz] *n.* 專門知識、技能；專長
Steven relied on his professor's **expertise** to guide him as he performed the experiments.

* **5. purchase** [ˈpɜːtʃəs] *n.* 採購之物；購買行為 *v.* 購買、採購 (第 33 行)
Heather made a **purchase** of a new computer during the sale.

* **6. portable** [ˈpɔːtəbəl] *adj.* 輕便的、便於攜帶的、可攜式的
Wade has a **portable** speaker that lets him listen to music wherever he goes.

- * follow sb's lead 表示「效法某人、跟著某人做」。
- * be committed to N. [kəˈmɪtəd] 表示「投入於、致力於……」。
- * say 在此為插入語，在對話中用來引起對方注意，亦可用於表達驚訝的情緒。
- * steer (sb) wrong 指「給(某人)錯誤的建議」，steer [stɪr] 在此作動詞，指「帶領、引導」。
- * for starters 表示「首先、一開始」，意同於 to start with、to begin with。
- * good call 指「好的選擇、正確的決定」，用來指對某個決定或判斷表達支持或贊同的口語說法。
- * hard to beat 字面意思是「難以被打敗」，用來指某事物非常棒，而別的事物也不太可能比它更好。
- * get one's feet wet 表示「某人剛開始體驗某事、熟悉新的情況」。
- * shell (sth) out 指「拿出(一大筆錢)、支付」，之後常接 for N.，表示「支付……」。
- * not sb's cup of tea 表示「不是某人感興趣的、不合某人心意的」。
- * with (any) luck 表示「一切順利的話；但願」。
